CAMP RULES: Failure to follow camp rules may cause any person or group to be sent home immediately.

1. A Fire drill will be held with each group at the beginning of each camp.
2. Campers are **NOT** permitted near the lake without adult supervision.
3. All facilities are to be kept clean and orderly at all times.
4. No rock music or dancing is allowed.
5. Gambling is not permitted.
6. No profanity.
7. The use of alcohol or drugs will not be tolerated.
8. Parking is allowed on **road areas only...parking on grass near the dormitories is forbidden.**
9. Camp fires are permitted in approved areas only. Wood for bonfires must be collected by each group. Wood for the fireplace is supplied in the woodshed, but is not to be used for bonfires.
10. Camp facilities are to be left as nice and clean as they were when your group arrived. No vandalism or graffiti to camp facilities will be tolerated. A campground 'walk through' inspection will be conducted with each group leader to determine camp condition at the end of each camp meeting. In the event there is new damage, or the camp is not properly cleaned, expenses will be deducted from your security deposit. If the security deposit will not cover the cost, the church or organization will be billed for the difference. If damage

or vandalism is found after a camp has been dismissed, a bill for damages will be sent to the church or organization.

11. It is important that boys and girls stay in their own areas. Girls are not allowed in the boys dorms, and boys are not allowed in the girls dorms.

COUNSELOR REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years of age.
- One counselor required for every 8 campers.
- No counselor can be allowed to cook.
- Counselors must be responsible for the children or young people that they supervise.
- Counselors are required to sleep in the same area as their group.
- A counselor must remain with their group at all activities, classes, ect.
- We do not allow campers in the dormitories without adult supervision.

RULES FOR DORMITORY AND KITCHEN USE

Materials are provided for maintaining camp facilities. We **require** all campers to clean facilities before departing the camp. Clean up lists are supplied as guidelines to expedite cleanup procedures.

POOL REQUIREMENTS

It is a requirement that every person must shower before entering the pool.

No one is allowed in the swimming pool building without an adult acting as lifeguard. Any person that acts as lifeguard must have a current CPR card. The pool building is to be kept locked when not in use and the key is returned to proper place. **EVERY PERSON THAT ACTS AS LIFEGUARD MUST MEET WITH CAMP DIRECTOR BEFORE THE POOL IS OPENED TO DISCUSS RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING POOL USE.**

RULES FOR USE OF THE 'PROPHETS CHAMBER'

The 'prophets chamber' is a special room for guest speakers, evangelists and pastors. We do not allow children in this room at any time.

A WORD ABOUT HEAD LICE

At Bethel Youth Camp we strive very hard to offer a clean and well maintained facility. *We encourage each group to do a head check of all their campers before they come to camp.* If lice or eggs are found on any child during a camp session that child will be sent home immediately at their own expense and the group will be responsible for the cost of cleaning the facility. Protocols will be determined by the camp director at the time of detection.
